## Project Overview & Access

This project is a bespoke, high-performance web platform built for the **Dalai Lama Foundation**. It utilizes the **Ghost CMS** as a headless-ready backend with a custom-engineered theme designed for extreme scalability and ease of use.

## Technical Stack & Environment

The platform is containerized for consistent development and deployment across all environments.

- **CMS Platform:** Ghost v5.x (Headless Node.js architecture)
- **Theme Engine:** Handlebars (.hbs) with custom CSS/Vanilla JS
- **Database:** SQLite3 (Local) / Compatible with MySQL (Production)
- **Containerization:** Docker & Docker Compose
- **Design Policy:** 100% Dynamic, Strict No-Hardcoding Policy

*[!NOTE] **Environment Management:** The `docker-compose.yml` file is configured for local development on port 2368. For production, ensure the `url` environment variable corresponds to your live domain.*

## **Architecture: The "No-Hardcoding" Strategy**

The core advantage of this platform is the **Dynamic Mapping Architecture**. Unlike traditional themes, this theme is "blind"—it doesn't have hardcoded text. Instead, it looks for specific **Page Slugs** and **Internal Tags** to populate the site.

- **Dynamic Homepage Sections:** Section titles and descriptive text are managed via hidden Ghost Pages with specific slugs (e.g., `section-highlights`).
- **Conditional Layouts:** Applying a "Custom Template" in the Ghost Page editor instantly changes the visual rendering (e.g., `About`, `Team`, `Our Work`).

## **Internal Content Logic (Tags & Slugs)**

For a developer taking over this project, these are the critical identifiers being queried by the theme engine:

Identifier	Type	Usage / Logic
home-hero	Page Slug	Queries title, excerpt, and background image for the main hero.
section-highlights	Page Slug	Renames the Highlights section header on the homepage.
#site-stat	Internal Tag	Renders post titles as numerical metrics in the impact grid.
#team-leader	Internal Tag	Spotlights the individual profile on the Our Team page.
#program	Internal Tag	Flags a post for inclusion in the horizontal program slider.
partner-logo	Tag Slug	Queries all tags sharing this slug to build the partner logo carousel.

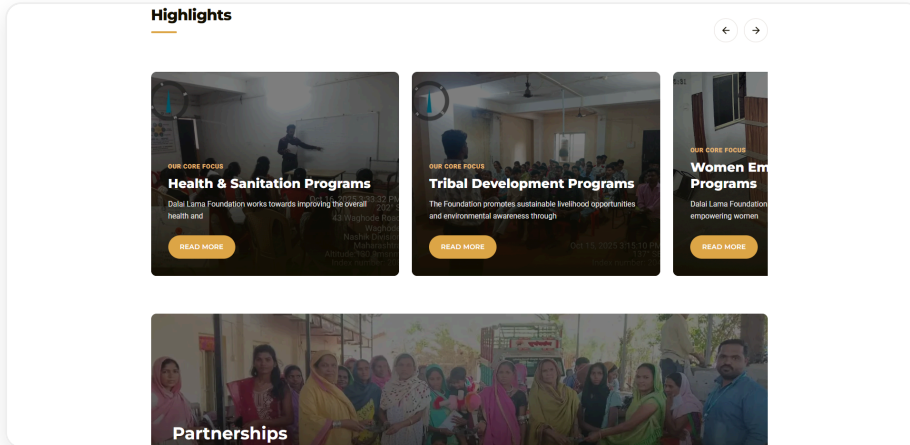

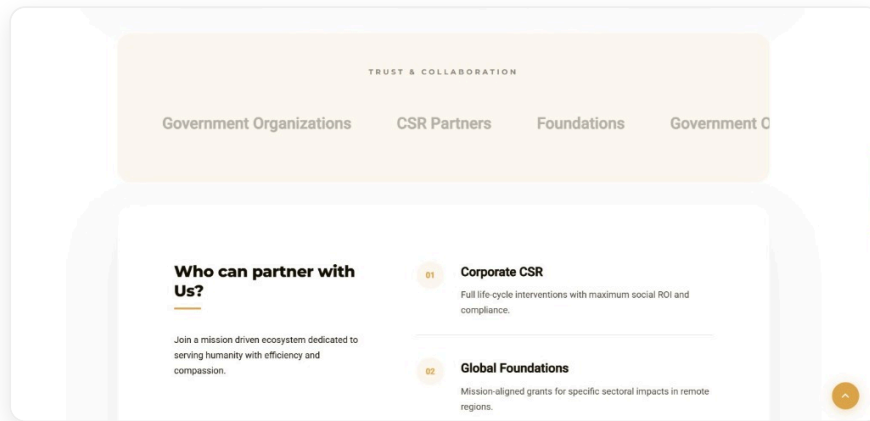

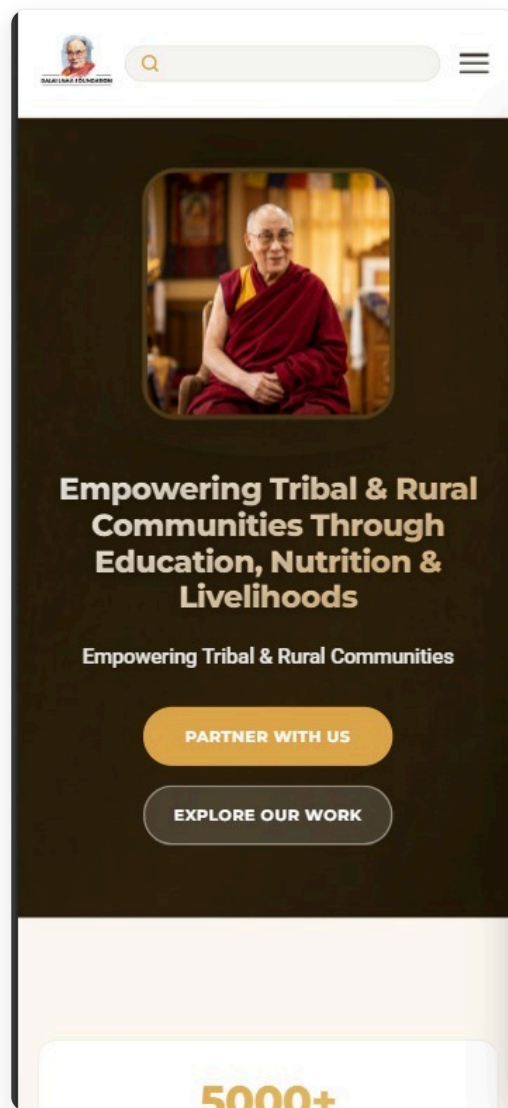

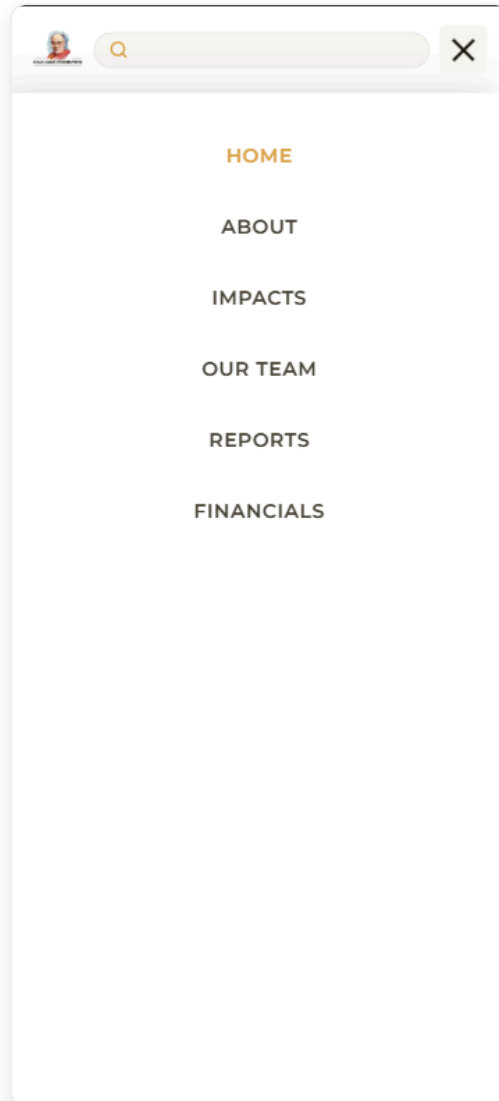

## 1. The Deployment ZIP


The final production theme is located in the Google Drive folder as `mytheme-compressed.zip`. This file is ready to be uploaded directly into the Ghost Admin settings under **Settings** → **Design** → **Change Theme**.

## 2. Routes Configuration

Upload the provided `routes.yaml` file to **Settings** → **Labs** → **Routes Configuration**. This file contains the custom permalinks required for the partnership and action buttons.

## 3. G-Scan Compatibility

The theme has been verified through **Ghost G-Scan** and achieved a **100/100 score** for compatibility, security, and standards.
